Attendance	Any absence that is not made up is considered unexcused. The reason for the absence is not important but <i>each missed 1-hour class</i> should be made up with a tutor and a make-up sheet completed. <i>See attendance policy for further details.</i>	10 unexcused absences (per class, not day)	5 unexcused absences (per class, not day)

- Students must complete at least 2 activities from each category (Ministry, Scholastic and Community) in addition to attendance requirements in order to achieve a KAL certificate.
- Students must weekly record number of church visits, hours of study and hours of visits within immersed Arabic environments. Each week these numbers must be submitted to Kelsey Administration during *family time*.
- At the end of each semester, each student's average is calculated by Kelsey administration.
- Students can choose to pursue Academic or Honors level certificates.
- KAL Honors certificates will be earned by students who complete two from each category at the Honors level.
- KAL Academic certificates will be earned by students who complete two from each category at the Academic level or above.
- **Student reports are also offered at the end of the semester which detail each student's overall investment of time and effort in studying the Arabic language.**
